Volunteering at the Hostfest at Minot, ND



Volunteering dates: Thursday September 21 – Saturday September 30 Hostfest dates: Wednesday September 27 - Saturday September 30

If you are willing to volunteer at the Minot Hostfest, this is the information. Our jobs will consist of parking RVs, manning a gate, and registering RV's. The registration and parking will begin on Thursday September 21st. You won't have to be there on Thursday but probably soon after. The parkers will hold your parking spot until Saturday the 23rd. There will still be parking spots after that time but you will have to park in random spots that are available. **There is NO fee for parking this year!** We will run (3) four hour shifts for each job per day. For a free one day admission pass to Hostfest (concerts not included), you will be asked to work a four hour shift. We have a total of 72 shifts to fill with people.

I want to remind members that the Ramblin' NoDaks membership list is for personal use only and is not to be shared with any other business, group or organization. As of June 6, 2023, FMCA has 71,435 RV units of which 10,014 are towable. I received these statistics at the Midwest Area rally,

There were 24 RVs and 1 drive-in attending the July rally in Grafton, ND with the Canadian Northern Lights. Thank you to the Canadian Northern Lights for hosting the July rally. We are going to try to have 1 joint rally with the Canadian Northern Lights each year. Chapter hosting for the rally will alternate every other year. We only have 2 rallies left for this year. The August rally will be held August 18-20 at the Elkhorn Ridge RV Park in Spearfish, SD. The September rally will be held September 7-10 at the Lewis and Clark RV Park in Hazen ND.

Pre-Registration is required for both rallies. The registration form for the August rally can be found in the email with this newsletter or on the Ramblin' NoDaks Website. The registration forms for the September rally will be coming out in an email with the August newsletter.

We continue planning rallies for 2024 and 2025. I still need hosts/locations for August 2024, May 2025 and August 2025. If you have suggestions on dates, locations or would like to volunteer to host a rally in 2024 or 2025, please contact me. I would encourage everyone to consider hosting a rally. If you don't want to host on your own, find someone to partner with. Here's the rallies already scheduled for 2024 and 2025.


Ramblin' NoDaks membership books for sale




FMCA Bylaws Article III #4E
