
Ramblin' NoDaks membership books for sale







Fiesta Bake

2 tubes of cresent rolls

2# hamburger (browned and drained)

2 c salsa

4 c shredded cheese



Press 1 tube of crescent roll dough into a 9 X 13 pan. Bake according to roll recipe. Mix hamburger and salsa together. Pour onto crust. Top with 1/2 of the cheese and cover with the other tube of crescent rolls and then top with remaining cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes.
