### Triple E Factory Tour

P.W. Enns, founder of Triple E, operated a plumbing and heating business in Winkler, Manitoba. While serving on a volunteer trip in Elkhart, Indiana, P.W. realized an opportunity in travel trailer manufacturing within Canada. In 1965, he enlisted his two sons-in-law, Peter Elias and Phil Ens, and together they manufactured their first travel trailer. Triple E was incorporated on October 17, 1965.

After 70 years of continues business, Mike Elias, Grandson and CEO of Triple E, oversee the manufacturing, of the Leasure Travel Van & Wonders Class C motorhomes, built to the highest quality standard of any RV in the business. The factory will provide insight on how Triple E's quality control and craftsmanship makes it one the most successful selling RV in the market.

### Dead Horse Cider Co.

There's antique tractor parades (11:00 am and 1:30 pm) as well as children's activities including barrel train rides, corn grinding, hands-on interactive stations. All the buildings are open including the General Store with its old-time prices for ice cream and treats PLUS lunch can be purchased in the Dining Hall from 11:30 am - 1:00
